


## Steel Trash Receptacle

1. Select a good visible spot in your community or park where you want to install the **Steel Trash Receptacle**.
2. Insert the mounting post (2" x 2" x 4') approximately 14" into an 18" deep by 8" diameter hole filled with a 40 lb. bag of "ready to use" concrete mix. To stabilize the post while cementing, place a rod, bolt or other device through the two bottom holes, prior to inserting into the ground and cementing. Level the post in a straight vertical position and let concrete dry for at least 12 hours.
3. Install the **Steel Trash Receptacle** through the pre-drilled top oval holes in the back wall of the receptacle and through the square post with the bolts, washers and locknuts, using the 2¾" bolt on top and the 2½" bolt on bottom. The upper back wall of the trash receptacle is supposed to touch the head of the lower post bolt, which creates some space between the post and the receptacle allowing the receptacle lid to open from left to right without touching the post.
4. Insert one of the enclosed **Pet Waste Bags** into the trash receptacle, folding it over the interior retainer bands. Proper installation and general maintenance will help expand the life of the trash receptacle. **Steel Trash Receptacle** offers Product Maintenance Paint to help cover any paint chips which may occur in the powder coating during the life of the product.
