

7'L Concrete Picnic Table with Cedar Top Model: 154-1173

- 1. The tables should be assembled and set in place on a firm, level surface, preferably concrete.
- 2. Stand the legs upright where the table will sit. The legs will not stand alone. Someone will need to hold them or they need to be propped up until you attach a redwood piece.
- 3. Place the wood on the legs (the notch is where the legs fit in).
- 4. Place the bolts through the wood into the inserts in the legs and tighten just snug with a 7/32" Allen Wrench. After all bolts have been started, make sure all pieces are level and plumь, then go back and tighten all bolts. DO NOT over tighten bolts.
