

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR 154-1162 - 7' Mesa Rectangular Concrete Picnic Table

1. The table should be set up on a flat, level surface; preferably a concrete pad.

2. Determine where the legs will be set, and place the legs upright. The legs may need to be propped up, or someone may need to hold them in place, as they will probably not stand freely.

3. One of the bench seats should be attached to the legs first. If lifting is to be done by mechanized means(forklift, crane, etc.), care should be taken not to mark or damage the concrete product. Do not use bare chains or cables. Fabric lifting straps are best.

4. The short (2"x3"x7") angle brackets are used to attach the bench seats to the legs. The longer brackets (2"x3"x11") are used to secure the table top. There are no washers between the concrete and the brackets. The washers are placed between the bolt and the bracket.

Bolts should be snugged tight, but do not overtighten!

- 5. The table top is then attached to the legs, then the other bench seat is attached to the legs.
- 6. Double check to make sure table is level.
